EMM's Strategic Plan & Future

In 2020, many of you generously supported EMM through donations, as we raised match funds for a USDA Rural Business Development Grant. Our application was deemed eligible by USDA, however they ran out of program dollars on the cusp of funding our project. These funds were planned for re-vamping our website, to serve as a regional marketing tool; promoting businesses and destinations through our highly successful social media channels; writing a strategic plan; and executing a marketing campaign to promote the region, given the the effects of the pandemic.
